

LOCAL RULES

See temporary local rules on pro shop board

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS**
 - (a) All ground beyond the Club's boundaries is out of bounds. See Rule 27.1.
 - (b) Works compound and residence adjoining 18th hole as defined by white stakes. Rule 27
- 2. WATER HAZARD**

The lake in front of the 18th tee – the limits of this hazard are defined by yellow stakes. Rule 26.1

 3. **LATERAL WATER HAZARDS** The limits of these hazards are determined by red stakes.
 - (a) The lake adjacent to the 13th tee and 15th and 17th greens.
 - (b) The lake between the 9th and 10th holes. During the play of the 9th hole only, a player may play a provisional ball for a ball which may be in the water hazard. If a provisional ball is played and the original ball is in the water hazard, the player may play the original ball as it lies or continue with the provisional ball in play, but he may not proceed under Rule 26.1
 - (c) The pond between the 16th and 17th holes.
- 4. BUILDINGS**
 - (a) The Clubhouse and adjacent buildings and the Motel Buildings are immovable obstructions. Relief may be obtained under Rule 24 (2).
 - (b) If a ball lodges in the area bounded by the pool fences and motel walls, the nearest point on the course outside that area shall be determined which is not nearer the hole. The player shall lift the ball and drop it within 2 club-lengths of the point thus determined.
- 5. TREES AND SHRUBS**

Protection of young trees identified by being staked or guarded , relief MUST be taken under Rule 24-2.
- 6. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows:
If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
- 7. GARDEN BEDS**

Cultivated garden beds on the 7th & 18th tee and surrounding the Clubhouse and Motel Units are Ground Under Repair, play is prohibited and the player MUST take relief under Rule 25 (1).
- 8. ANT HOLES, BEDS AND MOUNDS**

Relief may be taken under Rule 24-1.
- 9. TEE SIGNS**

A ball striking a sign on ladies tee may be replayed without penalty.
